CBR: \$5.30-\$14.00:\$1.00 invested

CER: \$12-\$57/Symptom-Free Day

*Major Remediation*COST: \$3,796-\$14,858 per participant






EPA Award Winners

Considerations

- Perspective (e.g., payer, societal)
- Impact of targeting, intensity, staffing, scope, number of visits
- Levels of services
- Timeframe of measurement
- Benefit structure (e.g., lifetime limit, multiple residences, multiple patients in same residence)
- Some costs may go up, but net benefit likely to be savings
- Role of cost-neutral or cost-effective interventions in achieving the triple aim
- Ability to leverage other funding
