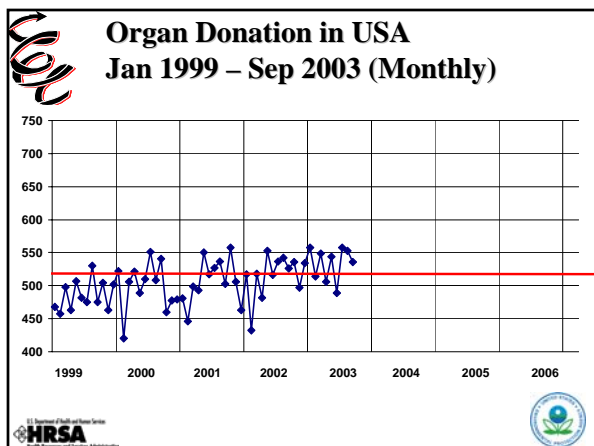



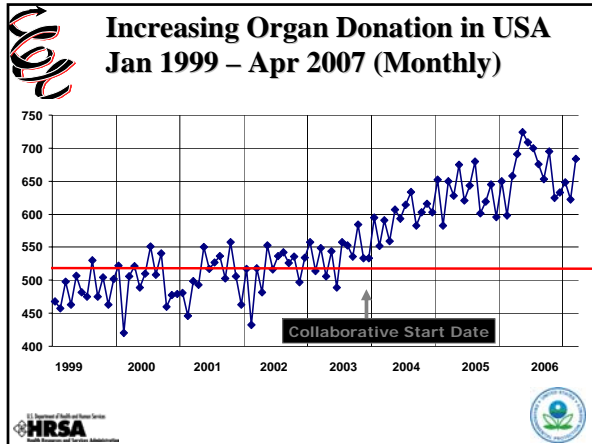


Using the Current Flow to Generate Progress and Results

...that Built Better Systems of Care, that got Results for Patients that have been Sustained over time

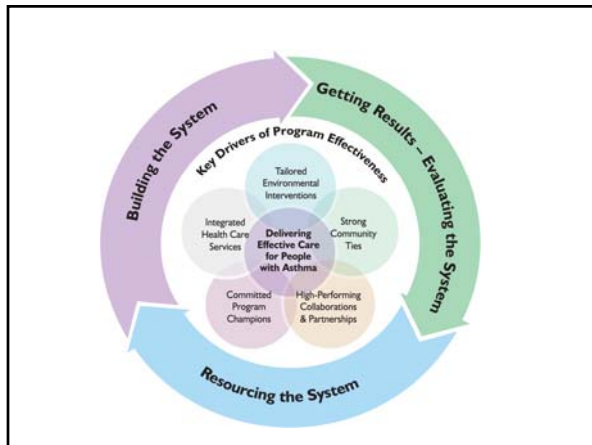
